

Comingled Guidelines

DO Recycle These

Glass Bottles – food containers - any color –
please rinse well

Beer bottles
Condiment bottles (mustard, olives, relish, etc)
Cooking oil bottles*
Drink bottles
Karo syrup bottles*
Liquor bottles
Mayonnaise bottles
Salsa bottles
Salad dressing bottles*
Vinegar bottles

Metal – cans and aluminum – please rinse well

Aluminum foil* (clean)
Beer cans
Beverage cans
Cookie tin
Metal bottle lids
Pie plate* (clean)
Soda cans
Soup cans
Vegetable & fruit cans

Plastic – #1- #7 containers – please rinse well

Beverage bottles (#1)
Cups (#1 or #6)
Flower Pots (#5)
Ketchup bottles (#1)
Milk bottles (#2)
Mustard bottles* (#1, #2 or #4)
Plates (only if labeled #6)
Shampoo bottles* (#1 or #2)
Soda bottles (#1)
Soap bottles (#1)
Yogurt containers (#5)

*these items often need more than a rinse to get reasonably clean

DON'T Recycle these

Glass that is NOT Recyclable

Auto glass
Drinking glasses
Glass from picture frame
Light bulbs
Mirrors
Pyrex
Tableware
Vases
Window glass

Metal that is NOT Recyclable Curbside**

Air conditioners
Auto parts (no oil, gas, or other fluids)
Bike parts
Freezer
Hangers
Lawn mowers
Nuts & Bolts
Pipes
Radiators
Refrigerators
Shelving
Stoves
Swing sets
Tools (hammer, shovel, rake, etc)

Plastic that is NOT recyclable

Any plastic not labeled #1 thru #7
Bags (even though some are #2)
Oil containers (too hard to get clean)
Plastic without a number on it
Styrofoam (may have #'s on it, but ignore)

** These items are recyclable at the Transfer Station in the scrap metal bin (not the bin for comingled cans, plastic & glass) except air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers cannot be disposed of at the Transfer Station
