

A Guide to Recycling in Marblehead



Curbside Recycling Program

Recycled materials are picked up weekly.

Bins may be obtained at the Transfer Station or at Health Dept. for \$7

- laundry baskets or 5 gallon plastic pails may be used

Paper:	Newspapers & inserts Magazines, catalogs Junk mail, Phone books Office paper (any color) Boxboard (cereal boxes) Corrugated cardboard - (must be broken down)	Place loose in bin Place bin at curbside	No photographs No Milk Cartons No soiled paper
Metal:	Beverage cans deposit or non-deposit Metal food cans Aluminum Foil Aluminum trays & pie plates	Rinse clean & drain Labels may be left on	No aerosol cans No paint cans No coat hangers No wire
Plastics:	Beverage containers deposit or non-deposit Any plastic item marked 	Rinse clean & drain Remove lids Crushed or nested when possible	No motor oil containers No plastic bags No bulky plastics No styrofoam
Glass:	Bottles & Jars clear, brown or green deposit or non-deposit	Rinse clean & drain Remove lids Labels may be left on	No broken glass, light bulbs, windows, dishes, Pyrex, crystal, mirrors

Drop-off Recycling Program

Recycled materials may be taken to the Transfer Station on Woodfin Terrace
(off West Shore Drive near the Community Store)

from 7:30AM-Noon and 1:00PM-3:30PM Monday through Saturday.

A Town Facility Sticker must be purchased for \$65— they can be purchased at
the Transfer Station or at the Mary Alley Town Building (Treasurer's Office)

Swap Shed: Refer to Marblehead.org for hours of operation. Serviceable home items such as tools, toys, kitchen items, furniture, doors.

Other non-fee items: Yard waste, motor oil,

Fee required: Tires, car batteries, TVs, CRTs, large metal items such as bikes, grills, shelving, and appliances (except refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners can not be left).
